Dear participants:

Here we provide you with some information about the venue and scientific program of the II Argentine-Brazilian Meeting on Gravitation, Astrophysics and Cosmology, to be held in Buenos Aires, Argentina, from April 22 to 25, 2014.

Venue

We remind you that the meeting will be held at the Auditorium of Fundación Cassará, Avenida de Mayo 1190, Buenos Aires (one block from Avenida 9 de Julio). Here you can find a map of Buenos Aires city: <http://mapa.buenosaires.gob.ar/>. This quaint old building is located at the very center of Buenos Aires, at walking distance from the historical Plaza de Mayo, the National Congress, the Colón Theater, and some of the most famous streets of the city such as 9 de Julio and Corrientes Avenues and Florida street. Both talks and posters will be presented at the first floor of the Auditorium. The registration/help desk will be placed there too; at this desk you can find any information you need on the conference (e.g., payment, certificates, etc.). A member of the LOC will be available at the entrance of Fundación Cassará to assist the participants. If you arrive late, you will probably find the door locked for security reasons. In this case, we kindly ask you to ring the bell.

Program

The final program of the meeting, as well as the abstract book, are available at the website of the conference: <http://graco2.iar-conicet.gov.ar>. The program consists in 52 talks (10 invited, 42 contributed) plus almost 50 posters, and is divided into four sessions: Gravitation, Astrophysics, Cosmology, and Large Experimental Projects. If you think that your talk is misplaced, or if you have any problem with the date/time assigned to your talk, please contact the co-chair of the Argentinian SOC as soon as possible at pellizza@iar.unlp.edu.ar. Please keep in mind that we will make only minor changes to the program, and these changes will be made only for justified reasons.

Language

We are pleased to announce that GRACo II has now international (neither Brazilian nor Argentinian) participants. Some of them come from countries where neither Spanish nor Portuguese are spoken. Hence, we strongly suggest you to give your talks and print your posters in **English**. Also, **English will be mandatory** for your slides, and for invited talks.

Talks

We remind you that contributed talks will be given 15 minutes, plus 5 minutes for questions. Given that the meeting will be intensive, we kindly ask you to respect these limits. PDF and PowerPoint are the supported formats for the talks. If you need to use another format, or even use your own computer, please contact us at the official e-mail of the conference (before the meeting) or at the help desk.

Posters

There will be no formal poster presentations; we expect posters to be discussed in a relaxed way during the coffee breaks. However, due to the number of accepted posters, there will be two poster sessions: one during Tuesday and Wednesday (posters #1 to 24); the other during Thursday and Friday (posters #25 to #49). The number of your poster is given in the abstract book. The maximum size of posters is 1.00 m (width) by 1.20 m (height). Once again, we kindly ask you to respect these limits.

Proceedings

The proceedings of the II Argentine-Brazilian Meeting on Gravitation, Astrophysics and Cosmology will be published in electronic format only. The deadline for sending your contributions will be July 1st, 2014. Instructions for authors, and the corresponding templates, will be published in the meeting webpage as soon as possible.
